Snow and Ice Precipitation Warnings Service Levels

Platinum Level Warnings— (Low Tolerance)

- **24/7 Meteorologist Consultation & Notification of Warning calls INCLUDED**
- * Alerted to Borderline Events-Events that don't meet our standard warning criteria.
- * Borderline Events like Green 6 / Yellow 4 (G6/Y4) Color Code Weather Conditions.
- Best for contractors with clients that have a Low Tolerance for snow and ice.
- * Warnings/Updates will be emailed to 8 individuals or one email alias.
- * Clients will receive warning notification calls and texts up to 20 phone numbers.

Gold Level Warnings (Our Most Popular Warning Level!)

- **24/7 Meteorologist Consultation & Notification of Warning calls INCLUDED**
- * Warnings Using Our Standard Operational Warning Criteria (Y6/G4 Events)
- * Warnings/Updates will be emailed to 8 individuals or one email alias.
- Clients will receive warning notification calls and texts up to 20 phone numbers.



Silver Level Warnings

- **24/7 Notification of Warning Calls INCLUDED**
- * Warnings Using Our Standard Operational Warning Criteria (Y6/G4 Events)
- * Warnings/Updates will be emailed to 4 individuals or one email alias.
- Clients will receive warning notification calls and texts up to 10 phone numbers.

Basic Level Warnings

- * Warnings Using Our Standard Operational Warning Criteria (Y6/G4 Events)
- * Warnings/Updates will be emailed to 4 individuals or one email alias.
- Clients will receive warning/update notification texts up to 10 phone numbers.

Daily Weather Forecast (Winter Season Nov 1-Mar 31)

- Preferable to get a 6 day forecast from same source as your warning provider.
- Bliminates all of the noise that is out on Social Media platforms with inaccurate forecasts.
- * Issued daily at a time determined by the client.
- Detailed weather forecast including precipitation, temperature, wind elements for 6 days.
- * Each forecast period is Color Coded to easily see upcoming weather events.

Long Range Forecasts (Winter Season Oct 1-Mar 31)

- ❖ Issued Typically Twice Per Week.
- * Looking at the Weekly, Monthly & Seasonal Trends.
- * Helps with Planning & Staffing / Providing Cost Savings.

Pavement Temperature Forecast (Winter Season Nov 1-Mar 31)(Or Monthly)

- * Issued for a Site-Specific Location.
- * Issued daily at a time determined by the client. (Usually Afternoon For Next 24 Hours)
- * Hourly forecast of pavement temperatures & conditions, weather conditions.



Multiple Location Lightning / NWS Warning Alerting & Web Portal Login

- Real-Time Lightning Alerting Capabilities for multiple locations.
- * User configurable lightning alerts based upon distance.
- * Alerted to National Weather Service (NWS) Watches and Warning for multiple locations.

- * Web-based user login to view meteorological data including lightning and radar.

- Real-Time Lightning Alerting Capabilities for one location.
- * User configurable lightning alerts based upon distance.
- * Alerted to National Weather Service (NWS) Watches and Warnings for one location.
- * Alerts and All-Clears sent by email and/or text messages.

National Weather Service (NWS) Watch / Warning Alerting Only (NO Web Portal Login)

- * National Weather Service (NWS) Watches and Warnings for one location.
- * NWS Watches / Warnings can be emailed and/or sent via text messages
