### WARNING DISCUSSION

A WEATHER DISTURBANCE MOVING SOUTHWARD THROUGH THE REGION WILL BRING INTERMITTENT LAKE-EFFECT SNOW SHOWERS AND FLURRIES FOR TONIGHT INTO EARLY SATURDAY MORNING. IN ADDITION, THERE IS SOME CHANCE FOR A BIT OF SPOTTY FREEZING DRIZZLE TO MIX IN WITH SNOW SHOWERS/FLURRIES FOR TONIGHT INTO EARLY SATURDAY MORNING. CURRENTLY, AIR AND PAVEMENT TEMPERATURES ARE ABOVE FREEZING, BUT WILL FALL TO OR SLIGHTLY BELOW FREEZING LATE OVERNIGHT TONIGHT. AS SUCH, THIS WOULD RESULT IN SNOWFALL ACCUMULATION LESS THAN 1/4", AND ICE ACCUMULATION WOULD LIKELY REMAIN TO BE TRACE AMOUNTS ONLY. THIS WEATHER DISTURBANCE WILL LIKELY MOVE THROUGH THE REGION AND END PRECIPITATION BY MID TO LATE SATURDAY MORNING.
