LOW PRESSURE, THE REMNANTS OF TROPICAL SYSTEM BERYL, WILL PASS NORTH OF THE REGION THIS MORNING. AS SUCH, GUSTY NORTHWEST WINDS COULD BE AS HIGH AS 40 MPH THIS MORNING ALONG WITH SOME HIGHER PEAKS. CONTINUED WINDY THIS AFTERNOON WITH GUSTS STILL RANGING FROM 33-38 MPH BEFORE RELAXING FURTHER BY LATE THIS AFTERNOON AND INTO THIS EVENING.
